### **Description**

#### ***ASAM Criteria-(A) - Introductory course – Step 1 in the ASAM Series***

A general overview of ASAM as well as instruction related to the proper utilization of ASAM criteria for appropriate patient placement, and guidance for utilizing ASAM criteria to determine the appropriate treatment of patients based upon their level of care. The emphasis here and throughout the ASAM training series will be the use of the ASAM Criteria as a tool for initial client placement and ongoing services at a given level of care. This training will also address the role of ASAM in medical necessity and treatment planning.

**At the conclusion of this introductory-level training (ASAM-A), participants will be able to:**

1. List the six dimensions of multidimensional patient assessment
2. Explain how the five broad levels of care in recommended by ASAM criteria reflect specific services that are available throughout California
3. Demonstrate ability to apply ASAM risk ratings to information gathered through multidimensional assessment.

## Who Should Participate?

California Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment/Contract Providers and County Staff who are engaged in the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) process.
